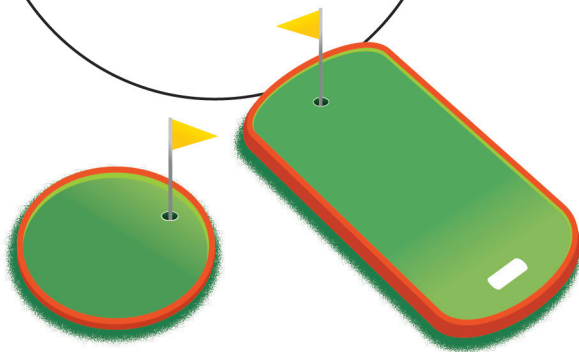

## Activity

### Dough Golf

#### What You Need:

Play-Doh®

#### What You Do:

“Sit at the table with me. I have a plan for this dough! Listen closely to my plan so you will know what to do. First, break off a piece of your dough and roll it into a ball. *(Pause.)* Great job!

“Next, use the rest of your dough to make a snake. *(Pause.)* Awesome!

“Now, pick up your snake and use it as a golf club to hit your ball. *(Pause)* Yay! You followed my plan and made a golf club and ball. Following plans can be so much fun!

“Today, we heard a Bible story about how God has plans for all of us, just as He had plans for Noah and Joseph. God has a plan for me, and God has a plan for you. Who has plans for you? God has plans for me!”

*(If time allows, allow your child to come up with their own plan for how you can next use the dough.)*
